

Partnership and Engagement policy

DRSC's capacity development activities target high educated (min Bachelor level) professionals in a position to influence and/or initiate road safety strategy making and implementation and/or road safety research infrastructure development. E.g. key players in middle and high policy level – in both public as private organisations, academic experts - researchers, lecturers at universities -, special professional target groups and NGOs – e.g. FIA members, World Bank staff, WRI.

Where possible and relevant in achieving its mission, DRSC will cooperate, work with and partner with academic institutions, nongovernmental organizations, private sector entities, philanthropic foundations, bilateral and multilateral organizations.

The basis for any engagement, cooperation with other stakeholders or accepting participants in a capacity development activity, is a clear benefit to DRSC's mission in contributing to safer mobility in LMICs through capacity development.

Each new proposed partnership will first undergo a case-by-case assessment carried out by the Director and the Board.
